O R D E R

While we may be of the opinion that preference should not be given for entry in temples on payment of additional entry charges, we do not think this question can be decided or a direction in exercise of writ jurisdiction under Article 32 of the Constitution of India, as prayed for in the present writ petition. These require mindset and societal changes, or for the management take remedial steps. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed.

We, however, clarify that dismissal of the writ petition would not, in any way, bar the authorities from taking appropriate steps or the public calling or the management doing what is required and necessary.
